MAYORS TO ANNOUNCE CITIES WHERE GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS HAVE PEAKED

On September 13, 2018, C40 Board President Michael R. Bloomberg will join C40 Chair and Mayor of Paris Anne Hidalgo and the mayors of some of the world's greatest cities to announce the cities in the C40 network where greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions have peaked.

The world's leading scientists have calculated that global greenhouse gas emissions need to peak by 2020 at the latest and then come down very steeply. City Halls around the world have already achieved this crucial milestone, whilst population numbers have increased and city economies have grown.

The announcement is part of the Global Climate Action Summit (GCAS) in San Francisco, one day after '[Cities4Climate: The Future Is Us](#),' a convening of mayors, changemakers, and climate experts hosted by C40 and the Global Covenant of Mayors for Climate & Energy (GCoM).
